Red Wine List

By The Glass

Cabernet Sauvignon

Montez – Colchagua Valley, Chile – 2013

A lively red color is the first clue that the wine before us is very fresh. Its aromatic potency is very well harmonized with its complexity. There's a predominance of red berries, jam, blackcurrant liqueur (creme de cassis), and a juicy sensation of crushed strawberries. Eight months in contact with French oak lend it a certain degree of seriousness, along with a bit of vanilla, smoke, cigar box, and sweet spices. Good balance on the palate with properly rounded tannins that enable this Cabernet Sauvignon to linger long on the palate.

Slow Press – Paso Robles, California – 2014

The Paso Robles AVA delivers a classic, rich Cabernet Sauvignon with bold, concentrated flavors. Slow Press Cabernet is aged in oak barrels for 11 months, and delivers notes of dark fruits and blackberries that complement robust and velvety tannins.

19 Crimes – Barossa, Australian – 2015

Wonderful paired with a scheme for an evening's escape, this wine conjures up red currants, dark berries and sweet vanilla oak in a passing smell. Caramel lurks in the back. Firm cabernet tannins and red fruits let the flavor linger after each nip.

Pinot Noir

Bogle – California – 2014

Floral aromas of violets and rose petals dance with wild strawberries on the nose of this wine. Silky and refined, brightens with ripe chokeberry and currant, while touches of pipe tobacco and worn leather round out the sip. Aged in French and American oak.

Morgan – Twelve Clones, Monterey California – 2014

This special wine demonstrates the power and finesse of Pinot Noir from the Santa Lucia Highlands. It displays aromas of dried cherry, cola, spice and smoke. Flavors of cranberry and pomegranate are complemented by notes of almond skin and minerals.

Zinfandel

Dry Creek Heritage – Sonoma County, California - 2014

The 2014 Heritage Vines Zinfandel is delicious and beautifully balanced. This vintage presents enticing aromatics of raspberries, cherry and a hint of toast and black pepper. On the palate, brambly flavors of ripe boysenberry and spicy dark chocolate come forward. The wine is complex, with bright acidity complimented by notes of berry syrup and mocha. The tannins are silky and smooth to lend a round, rich mouthfeel. From start to finish, this remarkable wine offers refreshing acidity paired with excellent structure.

Red Blends

Molly Dooker - Two Left Feet – Australia 2012

Shiraz, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon work together brilliantly! The combination brings complexity and depth to this wine. Rich fruit and luscious flavors dance upon creamy mouth-feel and firm structure. Perfectly balanced and intense this wine is exciting and already very drinkable.

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White Wine List

Chardonnay

Eve Charles Smith – Washington - 2014

A shimmering, brilliant, green golden of a wine. Aromatic pear, tangerine, guava, but more than anything, true Chardonnay flavor. Add a vein of minerality running through the middle. Long and satisfying.

Moscato

14 Hands - Washington – 2014

This light, smooth Moscato has aromas of white rose and ripe honeydew that are followed by flavors of peach and tangerine. While lightly sweet at first, ample acidity lends balance, keeping the wine bright and fresh.

Sauvignon/Fume Blanc

Ferrari Carano – CA – 2012

Ferrari-Carano's 2014 Fumé Blanc is a delicious wine with aromas and flavors of yellow peach, pear, quince, Meyer lemon, mango and fruit cocktail. This wine has bright acidity and crisp freshness from the cool, stainless steel tank fermentation, while the subtle oak character from barrel aging adds body, complexity and depth.

Dry Riesling

Pacific Rim – Columbia Valley, Washington - 2013

Pale straw yellow in the glass with a bouquet of Jasmine. Citrus, white peach and minerals on the palate. This wine is ideal with Asian and European cuisine and a wide variety of seafood, cheeses and cold meats.
